



JCB PLANERS

The JCB Planer can be used for detail cuts around curbs, manholes, and utility access covers. In parking lot and street repair the planer removes large areas of asphalt and concrete. The JCB planer is a valuable tool for repairing potholes and frost heaves and for removing asphalt or concrete prior to utility work.

FEATURES

- The open drum design improves planer productivity by reducing the power loss caused by the pics and drum passing through the already planed material.
- Large front access door for quick inspection and easy removal of pics.
- Center pivot design improves productivity by placing the force of the skid steer directly over the cutting drum. This also reduces instability and bouncing.
- Front down design keeps the front of the planer low to the ground providing a constant barrier for the planed debris.
- Direct drive design delivers the power directly to the drum.
